Allowable Courses

- Any course with the MUS or MUJ subject code that the student has met the prerequisites for. Subjects can cover Music Theory, Music History and Culture, Music Production, Music Performance and more.
- MUP 114, 115 (group studio instruction), MUP 165, 365* (individual studio instruction)
- Non-music courses:
 - o PSY 348 Music & the Brain
 - PHYS 152 Physics of Sound & Music

The Minor in Music Studies has the following requirements:

- 26 credits minimum overall from any music class
- 15 of those must be upper-division music credits
- No more than 12 credits of performance courses (ensembles, studio lessons)
- Courses applied to the minor must be taken for a grade (unless only offered P/NP)
- A minimum of 15 credits must be taken in residence at the UO.

Notes:

- Coursework from this minor may not be applied to any other music degree program or music minor.
- Cross-listed music courses (courses in other subjects which appear in a MUS subject search) may also count toward the music studies minor. Before enrolling, confirm pre-approval with Music Undergraduate Advisor (ugradmus@uoregon.edu).
- Other music courses may be approved by petition to the School of Music Undergraduate Committee. Petition and Override Request forms are available on the Undergraduate Music Resources page of the SOMD website (music.uoregon.edu).
