◆ Recommended Science area course for all music majors.

If chosen wisely, this course can be double counted in the Arts and Letters, Science, or Social Science Areas of Inquiry – this is STRONGLY recommended.

◆ Performance Majors are required to take 5 credits of upper division music courses. These may be taken any term.

*To earn 180 total credits required for the Bachelor's degree, students may need to earn additional college credit as specified.

[^] Piano Pedagogy sequence offered every other (even) year. If necessary, Piano Pedagogy sequence may be taken during sophomore year and Music History sequence taken during junior year.

× Must be a non-music class. Music requirements may fulfill 8 out of 12 required Arts & Letters credits for the Bachelor of Music degree. The remaining 4 credits must be taken in another area.
