**IV. Graduation Requirements**

- A minimum of 180 total credits earned.
- A minimum of 62 total upper division credits earned, 24 of which are in music.
- A minimum of 168 graded credits earned.
- A minimum of 45 of last 60 credits earned at University of Oregon.
- Meet with Music Academic Advisor for graduation check (3 terms prior to graduation term).
- Apply for graduation via DuckWeb one term prior to graduation date (check for deadline).
